

Eduroam is a free secure, world-wide wireless roaming access service developed for the higher education community. This service allows faculty, staff, and students to securely and seamlessly connect your wireless devices (laptop, tablet, or phone) to a participating institution's wireless network. It also allows faculty staff and students from other Eduroam schools to connect to Otterbein's wireless network when they visit our campus. Many educational events held in convention centers now provide Eduroam as a convenience to attendees.



Here are a few of the 45 locations just in Ohio: Denison University, Ohio State University, Kent State University, Ohio University, and the University of Rio Grande. Just walk on their campus and you're automatically connected!

Connecting to Eduroam is very simple.

- 1) Using your mobile device on our campus or at another Eduroam campus, check for available WiFi.
- 2) If "eduroam" appears, select it and enter your Otterbein credentials (*username@otterbein.edu* and network password).

While on campus you may connect to eduroam instead of "OtterbeinU". There is no additional benefit to using "OtterbeinU" name.
